There may also be a call to initiation to a particular Orisa. Need to follow spiritual guidance if we are having problems or confrontation with someone. Conflict with the law or the government. Our Ori is vulnerable and must be protected. This odu represents the alignment of ori and iponri. Our Iponri will help us accomplish the task at hand. Keep an extra vigilant eye on the children lest they have a serious accident. Ifa says a fight is imminent.

Ifa says that you are going to become a respected person in the world. Ifa assures you that when you are coming from heaven you were promised that it will not be difficult for you to become a leader on earth. All your followers shall adore and respect you and your leadership style shall be acceptable and satisfactory to your followers

This odu brings great blessings. What ever project you want to do, finish it as it will do well. It portends great successes.
